

Second Review Meeting of Coconut Producer Companies in Andhra Pradesh held on 9-1-2016

The second review meeting of Coconut Producer Companies in Andhra Pradesh was held on 09.01.2016 at Meeting hall, M/s Noveeal CPC, Amalapuram. The meeting was attended by Chairman and Director Board members from all companies registered in Andhra Pradesh. Shri.Jayanath R, Deputy Director i/c, CDB, Mrs. Isbel Rose Anto, Officer i/c, Coir Board and Shri.Rama Chandra Rao, Chief Instructor, Coir Board also attended the meeting. List of participants is annexed separately.

The meeting started at 10.00 am with the welcome speech of Shri.D.R. Raju, Chairman, M/s Noveeal CPC, East Godavari.



Shri. Jayanath R, Deputy Director i/c, CDB explained about the following in his introductory remarks.

- 1. Neera :** Neera committee visited Kerala and a favourable report permitting Neera extraction by FPO's in Andhra Pradesh is expected shortly. All CPCs are advised to select unemployed youths for neera technician training.
- 2. FPO formation:** Two more companies are registered after the 1st State level Review meeting of CPC and the new Directors were introduced. The FPO formations need to be speeded up so as to cover at least 50% of the total coconut area before February 2016.
- 3. Coconut Nursery:** Explained the need of establishing coconut nurseries and informed about the visit of Mr. Ram Mohan, Umaphathi Farms to the seed gardens in AP. The State is not having enough true to type GB plantations for undertaking hybridization. Umaphathi farms is willing to collaborate with

the CPCs in AP for producing D X T and T X D hybrids. The representatives of the companies may visit the Umapathi farms at the earliest.

- 4. Constitution of Committees:** For better monitoring of the envisaged task, constitution of committees are very essential. Only Noveel CPC has constituted 8 committees with specific duties. The remaining CPCs shall constitute the committees and report the progress immediately.
- 5. Fortnightly progress of activities:** Instructed the CPCs to report their progress of activities especially equity mobilization, planting material production & FPO formation on a fortnightly basis.
- 6. Fact Sheet:** Only Noveel CPC has returned the fact sheet. All CPCs should fill & submit the fact sheet at the earliest.
- 7. Company Office and appointment of Staff:** At present, M/s Chicof CPC, M/s Noveel CPC and M/s Sri Ramakrishna CPC have the company office with required staff. All the registered CPCs should have a company office with CEO and supporting staff. The necessary details and the activities with photos shall be provided for updating the CPC websites.
- 8. Scheme Implementation-LODP:** The Supply orders for all the selected CPSs have been given and the input distribution shall be expedited on priority basis.
- 9. Annual General Meeting:** All CPCs shall report the proceedings of AGM and submit yearly returns/mandatory records to ROC.
- 10. Training for Board of Directors:** The training for Board of Directors at MANAGE, Hyderabad has been approved. The batches are from 07.03.2016 to 09.03.2016 and 10.03.2016 to 12.03.2016. All the CPCs shall depute the Director Board members for the three day residential training programme.
- 11. FoCT training:** Only Noveel CPC has commenced the FoCT programme and completed 7 batches. All CPCs should ensure enough FoCT's in their jurisdiction.
- 12. Ball Copra Unit:** Ball copra is one of the profitable business in East Godavari dist. M/s Noveel CPC has initiated action to establish low cost structure for Ball copra production in all CPFs. Ball copra projects shall be submitted for getting in principle approval from CDB.
- 13. Soil Testing:** CPCs shall initiate this activity and soil samples from the LODP implementing area shall be tested. M/s Sri Ramakrishna CPC has already have soil testing lab and the FPOs affiliated to this company shall undertake soil testing.
- 14. Grading of CPCs:** As informed during the first review meeting, a grading system has been followed for the CPCs in Kerala and Karnataka. The parameters for grading the companies in AP will be finalized before next review meeting.
- 15. Training on coconut convenience food:** All the CPCs shall short list eligible persons for training in convenience food at CIT, Aluva.

Ms. Marjana Beegum K C, Technical Officer, CDB made a presentation on "Current Status of CPCs". She explained about the current system of monitoring adopted for CPCs in other states and ten point hundred scoring pattern in Kerala and Karnataka. Now, only 2 CPCs in Andhra Pradesh registered their website. Hence, all CPCs are requested to register their website and update the same. Fact sheet is distributed to the CPCs and advised them to provide their activities to CDB, State Centre, Hyderabad. Also informed about the actions to be initiated by all the CPCs like annual auditing of financial statements, filing of IT Returns to respective authorities, publishing the monthly Receipt & Payment Statement, Income & Expenditure statement, Profit & Loss statement and Balance sheet, and publish the same in CPC's website.

Shri Johar Khan, Board Member, CDB & Chairman, M/s Chicof CPC, Srikakulam in his address explained about the latest initiatives by CDB and motivated all Directors to form more collectives and avail the opportunities in coconut sector. He outlined the activities of M/s Chicof and stressed the need of forming a Consortium for CPCs in the state.

Shri. Ramachandra Rao, Chief Instructor, Coir Board, R.O, AP explained about the different schemes and assistance available for FPOs/CPCs. Smt. Isabel Rose Anto, Officer i/c ensured the support of Coir Board in all future ventures of CPCs.

The CPCs explained about their future plans and the DD reviewed the progress and given the following time schedule for completing the assigned tasks.
